

The following is an intelligence test that is different from the normal type. Most of the questions require some degree of creative thought. Try this test and write your answers on a different sheet of paper. Also test other people that you know; parents, friends, brothers and sisters. Your subjects should be over ten years of age.

1. If you went to bed at 8:00 and set the alarm to get up at 9:00 in the morning, how many hours of sleep would you get? (Use a regular clock).
2. Do they have a Fourth of July in England?
3. Why can't a man living in Winston Salem, N. C. be buried west of the Mississippi River?
4. If you had only one match and entered a room in which there was a kerosene lamp, an oil heater, and a wood burning stove, which one would you light first?
5. Some months have 30 days, some have 31. How many months have 28 days?
6. If a doctor gave you three pills and told you to take one every half hour, how long would they last you?
7. A man builds a house with four sides to it and it is rectangular in shape. Each side has a southern exposure. A big bear comes wandering by. What color is the bear?
8. How far can a dog run into the woods?
9. What four words appear on every denomination of United States coins?
10. What is the minimum number of active baseball players "in the field" during any part of an inning? How many outs in each inning?
11. I have in my hand two U. S. coins which total 55 cents in value. One is not a nickel. What are the two coins?
12. A farmer had 17 sheep. All but 9 died. How many did he have left?
13. Divide 30 by $\frac{1}{2}$ and add ten. What is your answer?
14. Two men were playing checkers. They played five games and each man won the same number of games. No ties. How is this possible?
15. An archeologist claimed that he found some gold coins dated 45 B. C. do you think he did? Why or why not?
16. Take two apples from three apples and what do you have?
17. A woman gives a beggar 50 cents. The woman is the beggar's sister but this beggar is not the woman's brother. How can this be?
18. How many animals of each species did Moses take aboard the Ark with him?
19. Is it legal in North Carolina for a man to marry his widow's sister?
20. How many one cent stamps are there in a dozen stamps? How many two cent stamps are there in a dozen?
